



EV Charging Policy for Employee Company Demonstrators

Any electric or hybrid company demonstrators driven by employees are not permitted to be charged on site.

Employees must charge their demonstrators for personal mileage, either at home or at a public charging station. If in doubt, please contact Victoria Starkey.

If an EV demonstrator is used for business mileage, i.e., training course or travel to another site, then please use the correct heading on the business mileage claim form – available from your site administrator.

If an EV demonstrator is required for demonstrator use by a customer, then the vehicle may be charged on site to fulfill the mileage required for that purpose only.

If an employee does not have the means to charge their vehicle off site, then we operate a monthly payroll fee for the cost of electric for full electric and hybrid models. Please see below for the price per month –

Full electric model - £100 per month

Hybrid model - £50 per month

Please advise which option you will be using on the acceptance of an electric or hybrid model vehicle.

Any employee found not to be adhering to the policy may face disciplinary action and the removal of their company vehicle.
